COMPLAINT AND ELECTION FOR JURY TRIAL

Plaintiffs, Lynn Lazzaro and John Lazzaro, III, by their attorneys, Paul D. Bekman,

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adosim (2017) Cashism EN (LYACIXM) Avan i Sacas Wendy L. Shiff, and Bekman, Marder and Adkins, L.L.C., sue the Defendants, Cyrus Hamidi, M.D. ("Dr. Hamidi"), Cyrus Hamidi, M.D., P.A., Lillian Hunter, M.D. ("Dr. Hunter"), and Perinatal Associates, L.L.C., as follows:

- 1. This case was originally filed in the Health Care Alternative Dispute Resolution Office. Plaintiffs elected to waive arbitration. Copy of Election to Waive Arbitration is attached as Exhibit A.
- 2. The venue for this claim is proper in Baltimore County, and may be proper elsewhere.
- 3. At all times herein, the Defendant, Dr. Hamidi held himself out to Plaintiffs, and to the general public as an experienced, competent and able physician and health care provider, possessing and providing that degree of skill and knowledge which is ordinarily possessed by those who devote special study and attention to the practice of medicine and surgery, and in particular, family and primary care medicine, and as such, owed a duty to the Plaintiffs to render that degree of care and treatment to her which is ordinarily rendered by those who devote special study and attention to the practice of medicine. At all times, Dr. Hamidi was acting as the agent, servant or employee of Cyrus Hamidi, M.D., P.A.
- 4. At all times herein, the Defendant, Dr. Hunter held herself out to Plaintiffs, and to the general public as an experienced, competent and able physician and health care provider, possessing and providing that degree of skill and knowledge which is ordinarily possessed by those who devote special study and attention to the practice of medicine and surgery, and in particular, obstetrics and gynecology, and as such, owed a duty to the Plaintiffs to render that degree of care and treatment to her which is ordinarily rendered by those who devote special study and attention to the practice of medicine. At all times, Dr. Hunter was acting as the agent,

servant or employee of Perinatal Associates, L.L.C.

- Plaintiffs, Lynn Lazzaro and John Lazzaro, III, are married.
- 6. On September 30, 2013, Lynn Lazzaro underwent an abdominal ultrasound, ordered by her family physician, Dr. Hamidi, for complaints of abdominal pain and cramps and other related symptoms. She reported that she had been experiencing these symptoms for 5 months. He also ordered a pelvic sonogram, which she underwent at the same time.
- 7. Dr. Hamidi received the ultrasound reports on September 30, 2013. The report of the abdominal ultrasound indicated that Mrs. Lazzaro had two small areas of slightly decreased echotexture in the liver. Due to the slightly rounded contours of these areas, the radiologist advised Dr. Hamidi to have Mrs. Lazzaro undergo CT evaluation. The pelvic sonogram showed small uterine fibroids. Dr. Hamidi instructed his staff to contact Mrs. Lazzaro to let her know that the ultrasounds were "ok". No recommendation was made for a CT or any other follow-up tests or evaluations.
- 8. A copy of the reports were sent to Mrs. Lazzaro's gynecologist, Dr. Hunter. In 2012, Dr. Hunter had expressed concerns to Mrs. Lazzaro about possible gynecologic cancer. Dr. Hunter did not mention the sonograms nor the recommended CT at any follow-up appointments.
- 9. Mrs. Lazzaro continued to see Dr. Hamidi for general medical complaints. In June 2014, he ordered routine blood studies for her. Her ALT (liver function study) was elevated. No further recommendation was made for a CT or any other follow-up tests or evaluations.
- 10. On January 22, 2016, Mrs. Lazzaro sees Dr. Hamidi for epigastric complaints. He ordered an ultrasound of the abdomen.

- 11. Mrs. Lazzaro underwent the sonogram that day. A stat report was made to Dr. Hamidi advising that the mass seen in 2013 which was less than one centimeter now measured 13.4 cm. It was highly suspicious for malignancy.
- 12. Mrs. Lazzaro sought treatment with Andrew Cameron, M.D., at The Johns Hopkins Hospital. He ordered an MRI which revealed that the tumor was inoperable and with the size and location of the tumor, she is not a candidate for liver transplant surgery.
- 13. On February 23, 2016, Mrs. Lazzaro began TACE treatment (transarterial chemoembolization) under the direction of Christos Georgiades, M.D., at The Johns Hopkins Hospital. Her prognosis is poor.

Count I-Negligence

- 14. Plaintiff, Lynn Lazzaro, incorporates paragraphs 1-13.
- 15. Defendant, Dr. Hamidi, was negligent and careless in his care and treatment of the Plaintiff:
 - a. by failing to advise her of the abnormality on the abdominal ultrasound of September 2013;
 - b. by failing to recommend that she undergo a CT study of the liver following the recommendation of the radiologist who interpreted the September 30, 2013 ultrasound;
 - e. by failing to correlate the abnormal ALT result of June 2014 with the
 September 30, 2013 ultrasound or ordering further CT studies or testing or
 evaluations;
 - d. and in other ways.
 - 16. Defendant, Dr. Hunter, was negligent and careless in her care and treatment of the

Plaintiff:

- a. by failing to advise her of the abnormality on the abdominal ultrasound of
 September 2013;
- b. by failing to recommend that she undergo a CT study of the liver following the recommendation of the radiologist who interpreted the September 30, 2013 ultrasound;
- c. and in other ways.
- 17. As a direct result of the negligence of the Defendants, Plaintiff, Lynn Lazzaro, has suffered painful and permanent injuries, and was and will be caused to sustain severe mental anguish and emotional pain and suffering; whereby she was and in the future will be prevented from engaging in her usual activities; was caused to incur and will in the future incur medical and other expenses and was caused and will incur financial losses and damages and will continue to experience said mental anguish, pain and suffering in the future.
- 18. All of the losses, damages and injuries sustained by the Plaintiff were caused by the carelessness, recklessness and negligence of the Defendants without any negligence on the part of the Plaintiff thereunto contributing.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff, Lynn Lazzaro, claims damages to be determined by a jury.

Count II-Loss of Consortium

- 19. Plaintiffs incorporate by reference paragraphs 1-18.
- 20. As a result of the negligence of the Defendants, Plaintiffs have suffered injury to their marital relationship.
- 21. All of the losses, damages and injuries to the marital relationship of the Plaintiffs has been caused by the carelessness, recklessness and negligence of the Defendants, without any


negligence on the part of the Plaintiffs thereunto contributing.
